

Audit of accounts 2012/13 - Notice of certification of completion of the audit

I am pleased to advise you that the audit of Charnwood Borough Council's accounts for the year ending 31 March 2013 has been completed. I have issued a certificate of completion of the audit dated 6 May 2014.

An unqualified opinion on the accounts was issued on 19 September 2013. On the same date I also issued an unqualified conclusion on the Authority's arrangements for securing value for money as required by the Audit Commission's Code of Practice.

I have not had to exercise any statutory audit powers under the Audit Commission Act 1998.

Issue of audit opinion on the financial statements
