

**ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR
CHARNWOOD COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP MINIMUM STANDARDS
CHARNWOOD BOROUGH COUNCIL'S EXPLANATORY NOTES**

Standard 1

In 2009, Charnwood's Community Safety Partnership carried out a borough wide Anti-social Behaviour Survey, which sought community views on anti-social behaviour and measured, amongst other things, satisfaction with the way anti-social behaviour complaints were handled jointly by the police and borough council. The survey will be repeated annually, and from 2010 will include a question designed to measure the percentage of people, living and working in Charnwood, who perceive a high level of anti-social behaviour in their area.

In 2008 the Place Survey recorded a perception percentage of 15.4%. This survey measures Community Safety Partnerships performance, at borough district level.

The 2009 British Crime Survey recorded a perception percentage of 13.3%. This survey measures performance across police constabulary areas – Leicestershire.
