It recognises the specific need to publicise enforcement action which is taken to address local issues and to that end Charnwood Borough Council has produced procedural guidance for such publicity.

Good use is made of local websites, including that of Charnwood Borough Council and Local Strategic Partnership, to publish progress updates relating to the wider Community Safety Plan. Newsletters are issued regularly by Police Beat Teams and the Local Policing Unit Commanders, which identify local anti-social behaviour priorities and the responses given to these. Articles are frequently issued to the press for inclusion in local weekly and daily newspapers, in addition to parish council magazines. Charnwood Borough Council also produces a quarterly publication, Charnwood News, which is distributed to every household in Charnwood and provides local residents with updates regarding progress made in tackling anti-social behaviour and other community safety issues.
