Charnwood Borough Council recognises the negative impact of these signal crimes on community confidence and perception. It appreciates the need to remove graffiti swiftly to deter others, to reassure local residents and to promote community pride in residential areas.

We will achieve this through clear reporting lines that ensure that all incidents are logged, investigated and appropriate action taken at the earliest opportunity. All reports will be dealt with on an individual basis and feedback/updates will be available for on going cases. Operational or referral actions to partner services or agencies will be completed to ensure and inform partnership working.
