Community Safety Survey 2006

Final Report

1. Introduction

The consultation was carried out by the Communications, Consultations and Partnerships Team in May - June 2006 on behalf of the Community Safety Team.

The aims of the survey were as follows:

- Identify types and locations of crimes occurring.
- Identify reasons behind fear of crime.
- To gather views about anti-social behaviour.
- To gather views about community cohesion.

2. Executive Summary

2.1 Methodology

A paper questionnaire was sent via the post to every member of the Charnwood Citizens Panel (see 2.2 below) and was made available on the Council Website.

2.2 Sample Size

A total of 600 responses were received.

2.3 Reliability of Results

This sample can be considered to be a valid, general representation of the views of residents of Charnwood because:

- The sample size exceeds the recognised number required to provide statistical reliability (500) for the Borough* This means that we could be confident that a wider, larger sample would produce similar results.
- The sample was closely representative of the demographics of the borough in terms of gender and ethnicity and to an extent (but less so) of age and location within Charnwood. It is important to note that people aged 18-29 were the most under-represented and people aged 50-65 were the most over-represented. This is a nationally occurring trend for citizens' panels.

3. Main Findings

This section identifies the main findings of the survey.

Note* Where figures for the percentage of respondents who are satisfied with a particular aspect of the service is given, this is a combination of both the satisfied's and very satisfied's.

The Main findings of the survey were as follows:

- 68% of respondents have been a victim of crime.
- Of those people who have been a victim of the crime, the most common crimes were related to their home or their vehicle.
- The main concern for people in their local area is young people hanging around the streets (34.6% of respondents) followed by people being drunk and rowdy (20%)
- 46% of respondents felt that licensed premises in the local area increased crime but 48% felt it had no effect at all.
- CCTV was seen as the most effective method of preventing crime in licensed premises.
- 44% of respondents feel unsafe when going out in town at night.
- 35% feel unsafe when withdrawing money from a cashpoint, bank or post office.
- CCTV presence and police response are the things that most make people feel safe.
- 65% of respondents said that groups of young people hanging about made them feel unsafe.
- The most frequent anti-social behaviour to affect respondents is nuisance from vehicles.
- 76% of respondents felt that Charnwood is a place where people from different backgrounds get on well together.

4. Conclusion

Whilst the outcome of this survey cannot be used to say that it reflects the view of the whole borough, it does provide a general indicator and highlights a number of issues across the services that the Council provides that need to be addressed if we are to increase levels of satisfaction.

The main concerns expressed by residents that can be seen to be impacting on levels of satisfaction are:
