Recommendation

That the delegated function of the Head of Paid Service (Chief Executive) to authorise officers to issue, cancel or vary a closure notice covering a period of up to 48 hours be assigned to the Head of Landlord Services, the Head of Neighbourhood Services, the Head of Strategic and Private Sector Housing, and the Head of Regulatory Services.

Reason


To enable the delegated function to be discharged efficiently, and an effective response to the prevention of disorder.

Authority for Decision

The Chief Executive, as head of paid service, has delegated authority within the Constitution to authorise officers to issue, cancel or vary a closure notice covering a period of up to 48 hours.

Authority for the further delegation of decisions or functions by the officers to whom they are delegated to other officer(s) is given in the Scheme of Delegation in Chapter 3 of the Council's Constitution, subject to the delegation being recorded and a copy of that record being provided to the Monitoring Officer. Such a delegation does not prevent the taking of the decision or discharge of the function by the officer who delegated it.
