Reason

To create needed space in market yard by disposal of assets which are not needed for town centre operations, and to achieve income for the Council.

Background

Two trailers previously used for the movement of markets and town centre infrastructure are now Beyond Economic Repair (BER) and need to be disposed of due to lack of space in the yard. Whilst they are BER they do carry a value. Having carried out a process of establishing a fair market value for each of the 2 trailers these have been offered for sale and 2 offers have been received:

Trailer 1 was offered for sale at £2000 hoping to get an offer above £1500 Trailer 2 was offered for slae at £500 hoping to get on offer above £300.

Offer 1 received was for trailer 1 only at \pounds 1,750. Offer 2 received was for both trailers at \pounds 2,350. It therefore decided that Offer 2 should be accepted and both trailers sold as seen.
