**VARIATION OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE FARES**

Charnwood Borough Council intends to vary the table of hackney carriage fares applicable in the Borough, in accordance with Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976. If no objections are received the variation to fares will be implemented, with effect from 1st August 2010, as follows:-

For vehicles licensed to carry no more than 4 persons

	Tariff 1	Tariff 2	Tariff 5
For the first 440 yards or part thereof	£3.25p	£3.75p	£7.50
For each 220 yards thereafter or part thereof	17p	28p	56p
Waiting time for each 45 seconds or part thereof	17p	28p	56p

Tariff 2 applies only for hirings begun:

Between 11pm and 7am on any day

Between 7am and 11pm on Sundays

Between 7am and 11pm on Statutory Bank Holidays and Public Holidays

Between 8pm and 11pm on Christmas Eve and New Years Eve.

Fares from 6am on Christmas Day to 6 am on Boxing Day, and from 6 am New Years day to 6am on January 2<sup>nd</sup> are shown in Tariff 5

Children under 5 are carried without charge. Half the adult fare is charged for children between 5 and 12 years.

The following fare tariffs only apply to hirings where there are 5 or more passengers, in Hackney Carriages licensed to carry 5 or more passengers.

Tariff 4 applies only for hiring begun:  
between 11.00pm and 7.00am any day  
between 7.00am and 11.00pm Sundays  
between 7.00am and 11.00pm statutory Bank Holidays and Public Holidays  
between 8.00pm and 11.00pm Christmas Eve and New Years Eve

Fares from 6am on Christmas Day to 6 am on Boxing Day, and from 6 am New Years day to 6am on January 2<sup>nd</sup> are shown in Tariff 6

Children under 5 are carried without charge. Half the adult fare is charged for children between 5 and 12 years.

A copy of this Notice will be deposited at the Main Reception, Council Offices, Southfields, Loughborough and will be available for inspection without payment on Mondays to Thursdays between 8.30am-5.00pm and on Fridays between 8.30am-4.30pm for a period of 14 days from the date of this Notice.
