1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 5 May 2011** to decide on the question below:  
  
**At present, the UK uses the 'first past the post' system to elect MPs to the House of Commons. Should the 'alternative vote' system be used instead?**
2. The hours of poll will be from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Southfield Road, Loughborough, Leicestershire, LE11 2TX by 5 p.m. on Thursday 14 April 2011
4. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Southfield Road, Loughborough, Leicestershire, LE11 2TX by 5 p.m. on Thursday 21 April 2011
5. Applications to vote by proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, where that physical incapacity occurred after 5 p.m. on Thursday 21 April 2011 must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 p.m. on 5 May 2011.
