Returning Officer's Recommendations
February 2011

INTRODUCTION

This report considers each polling district and polling station under the current arrangements and the Returning Officer has, where applicable, considered known issues during the preparation of this document.

This Review has been the subject of consultation with a wide variety of partners, users, councillors and political groups and their views have been taken into account. Also, the Electoral Commission has instructed Returning Officers that following the issues on polling day last year, no polling station should serve more than 2500 electors (excluding absent voters). In some cases this has led to new and additional polling stations having to be found. In other instances, two polling stations have had to be established in some polling places and the electorate split between them.

Polling stations have been visited by a Council Officer who is trained in access requirements and health and safety matters for risk assessment purposes and their comments have been taken into consideration. A full risk assessment report will be made available for inspection and a copy is available in the Members' Room for councillors.

The Returning Officer is proposing to keep the existing polling arrangements and to make minimal changes only where circumstances require. The intention is not to make changes for change's sake.

GUIDELINES

The following considerations have been taken into account when drawing up these proposals. The first two are required by electoral law; the others are guidelines, not strict rules.

- The Council must seek to ensure that all electors have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances.
- The Council must seek to ensure that so far as is reasonable and practicable every polling place is accessible to electors who have a disability.
- Ideally, the polling place should be in its own polling district.
- There should be no more than 2500 electors (excluding absent voters) per polling district.
- Preferably, no polling place should be shared by two wards.
- Portakabins should only be used where there is no other reasonable option, as these are comparatively costly to operate.

THE TABLES

This report deals with each ward separately. For existing polling arrangements, the tables show:

- The polling district.
- The number of electors as at 1st December 2010.
- The polling station.
- A comment regarding the disabled access. It should be noted that the majority of polling stations show a comment of “satisfactory”. This does not necessarily mean that access is ideal, but that any shortcomings can be dealt with by the provision of equipment such as ramps and by the polling station staff at the time of an election. Where a risk assessment has been carried out, and there are known problems relating to access, a comment of “satisfactory pending re-assessment” is included.

The Council agreed the recommendations of the Returning Officer at its meeting held on 28th February 2011.
