NOTES

1. **A licence may be granted to an individual over the age of eighteen years or a body corporate. It will be a condition of any licence granted that the carrying on of the business of a riding establishment shall at no time be left in the charge of any person under 16 years of age.**
2. (i) **“Horse” includes any mare, gelding, pony, foal, colt, filly or stallion, and also any ass, mule or jennet.**

(ii) **The Act regulates riding establishments which let out horses on hire or use them for the purpose of providing, in return for payment, instruction in riding or for the purpose of demonstrating riding.**
3. **A licence is valid from the date of issue or from the first day of January next. Please state preference.**
