explanation of categories.

- **Best house or flat garden**, this is for all individual or family tenant and leaseholder gardens.
- **Best pots and hanging baskets**, we are looking for a good use of colour and space and making the most of the area available.
- **Best community garden**, for all shared communal garden spaces that add joy and beauty to improve the area.
- **Best sheltered court garden**, this category is only for sheltered courts.
- **Best fruit and veg edible garden**, we are looking for a varied, healthy garden with a good use of space and vibrant, appetising plants.
- **Best newcomer**, for tenants and leaseholders who have never entered the competition before.
- **Best young gardener** (age 16 and under), for all enthusiastic young gardeners no matter how big or small the garden is.
- **Best flower display**, this will be judged on the colour, variety, and overall impact of the garden.
- **Best eco garden**, this must show evidence of upcycling, care for the environment, care for insects, and a general awareness of the environment.
