Please note the following comments and if possible make appropriate changes to the document.

Re. Section 156

There appears to be an omission here resulting in contradictory wording. The section commences with

"Currently the fastest Internet connections in the parish at reasonable cost use "fibre to the cabinet" (FTTC -not currently available in the parish, nor are plans for it imminent). "

So it is saying that FTTC is available ("currently the fastest") but then that it is not available. It should perhaps read

"Currently the fastest Internet connections in the parish at reasonable cost use "fibre to the cabinet" (FTTC). The superior "fibre to the premises" (FTTP) is not currently available in the parish, nor are plans for it imminent."

Re. Policy BE7

Section 156 says that

"it is suggested that new premises should be capable of receiving say 50mbps at reasonable cost".

However, BE7 says

"Every individual dwelling in new housing developments should have a connection installed capable of supplying broadband operation at download speeds of at least **30** megabit and upload speeds of at least 10 megabit. (as at the date of publication) or better ...".

Logically, this should say

" ... download speeds of at least 50 megabit ...".

I hope that you will be able to make these or similar changes.
