- Or make some very easy Play Dough with the recipe below.

Homemade Play Dough Recipe

2 cups of Flour

1 cup of Salt

2 tablespoons Cream of Tartar

1 Tablespoon Oil

1 Cup of Hot Water

Food colouring (optional)

- Put the food colouring to one side
- Use a large bowl to mix all the other ingredients together
- Knead together to form the Dough
- Divide the dough into balls, one for each colour, if you are using.
- Add a few drops of the food colouring to the dough, one colour at a time
- Knead until evenly mixed.
