*Approximately 15.00*

*Church service will start. Precise time dependent on how long it takes for parade to enter the Church.*

15.45

*The Parade will re-assemble in Melton Road and then march south down Melton Road to the War Memorial for the wreath laying and a short service.*

16.10

*The parade continues south down Melton Road to The Royal British Legion Club turning left into the Car Park for the parade dismissal*
