# Officer Making the Decision

#### Recommendation

That 4 additional hours be added to Post M328 in Cost Centre L010 with effect from 10<sup>th</sup> May 2021 on a temporary basis until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022. The current number of hours in this generic post is 185.5, and after the change the number will be 189.5. From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 the number of hours will revert to 185.5.

Also, 7 hours be added to Post H589 in Cost Centre L010 with effect from 10<sup>th</sup> May 2021 on a temporary basis until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022. The current number of hours in the post is 30 and after the change the number will be 37. From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 the number of hours will revert to 30.

### Reason

To support the administration of the Welcome Back Fund, which is additional Government funding aimed at supporting the safe reopening of businesses after the Covid-19 pandemic.

### Authority for Decision

Section 8 of the constitution contains authority for the Chief Executive to agree changes to the establishment, within budget and without major service or policy implications, affecting no more than five posts (irrespective of their post number) in any single case (item 6 on page 8-4 of the constitution). This authority has been sub-delegated to Heads of Service in certain circumstances, which this situation falls within.

## **Background**

The temporary increase in hours will be supported by the Welcome Back funding, which is additional, external funding. The fund allows for an administration element of 4% of the total funding of £330.900 over 2 years to be claimed. This will amount to £13,236. The cost of the additional temporary hours are detailed in the financial implications below and the cost can be contained within the 4% fee.

The additional hours will allow for the co-ordination of resources to support the reopening of businesses and the promotion of safe and local shopping in our towns and villages, through the Seat Out campaign, a task force for localised support throughout the borough and organisation and promotion of events to attract visitors and new business. Support is also needed for monitoring of outputs and reporting to the Welcome Back Fund managers.

<u>Summary of Comments from HR:</u> Variation eform's will need to be completed for the current postholders increasing their hours. All employees working within post M328 have had an opportunity to express interest in taking up additional hours with only one person formally coming forward.

# **Financial Implications**

The fund allows for an administration element of 4% of the total funding to be claimed, this amounts to £13,236. (4% of £330,900), this is sufficient to cover the additional estimated cost of £10,900.
