Decision and Date

Background

The original s.106 agreement did not provide any provisions for the adoption of Open Spaces nor any sums in relation to this. As the intention of the Council is to adopt the open spaces (DD044 16/17) the original agreement needs to be varied to include provisions for open spaces

as well as securing financial contributions in relation to this. These financial contributions comprise of £29,943.00 for Off-site children's play facility and £12,294.96 for maintenance of the adopted open spaces.

The original agreement also included a healthcare contribution of £10,625.24. this had a spending limit of 5 years (it should have been spent by 17 April 2012). The NHS did not spend the contribution during this period therefore have requested an extension of time. The developer has agreed to extend this to the 12^{th} January 2019.
