## Background

Cityfibre has approached the Council to install full fibre infrastructure at HRA assets as part of a sub-regional scheme it is currently delivering. The installation is at no charge

Two presentations have been received from Cityfibre, and a site visit (the property was selected by the Council from a list) to a completed installation has been undertaken by the Council's Electrical Compliance Surveyor. There is a clear potential benefit to tenants, and the works were found to be of a good standard.

The wayleave agreement has been reviewed by the Council's Legal Services Team. Each installation at each block must be agreed by the Council, so if there is an issue with the quality of installations in the future, the Council may stop new installations from taking place.

Some sheltered stock will be excluded given the potential for future major improvements at sheltered accommodation which may impact on service media
