Recommendation

That the sum of £40,000 of section 106 monies that has been received as a contribution towards youth and adult recreation provision in Shepshed is paid to Shepshed Town Council for the provision of a parkour facility at Oakley Road Playing Fields.

Reason


To enable section 106 monies that have been received for the provision or enhancement of youth / adult recreation and community facilities in Shepshed to be spent.

Authority for Decision

Authority to pay over Section 106 monies in respect of non-housing items received by the Borough Council as the responsible authority, but which will not result in expenditure by the Council and where the Head of Service has been determined to be the relevant Head of Service by the Head of Finance and Property Services. (item 8 of the delegations to Heads of Service in section 8.3 of the Constitution)

(For the Head of Service to approve the release of funds they must be satisfied that the works to be carried out fulfil the requirements set out in the S 106 agreement and have written confirmation from the relevant body that the monies will be used for their intended purpose).

Background

Under the provisions of the Corporate Plan to 2016 - 20, there is a commitment to ensure that a growth in homes and infrastructure benefits residents through improved community facilities. In addition the Corporate Plan makes a commitment to encourage healthy lifestyles for all our residents through physical activity opportunities and the provision of sports facilities and open spaces.

Planning agreements negotiated with developers and land owners under Section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) provide a vehicle for the delivery of contributions towards infrastructure, facilities and amenities reasonably related in scale and kind to the development proposed and necessary to discharge fully the policy expectations of the Development Plan.

Detail

Within Shepshed there are a number of section 106 agreements that have been negotiated, with contributions for Youth and Adult Recreation and community facility provision.

Officers have received a request from Shepshed Town Council for section 106 monies towards the provision of a parkour facility at Oakley Road Playing Fields. The Town Council have been out for various quotes for the scheme and has consulted with local young people with regard to the design.

Oakley Road Playing Fields is owned by the Town Council and have provided evidence of security of tenure. The Town Council have provided the evidence of three quotes. The cost of the scheme is £40,000 and the request is for £40,000 of section 106 monies towards the scheme.

Officers are satisfied that the scheme meets the criteria for the use of the section 106 monies. The money will not be released to Shepshed Town Council until the scheme has been completed and appropriate invoices have been received to ensure verification that the money has been spent on the intended purpose and a site visit has been undertaken.

Shepshed Town Council have provided information in relation to this project including quotes, evidence of security of tenure, confirmation that they will be responsible for ongoing maintenance.
