Eligibility Checklist

This checklist is designed to help applicants decide if their organisation and project are eligible for a Charnwood Member Grant. We recommend you read and go through Part 1 and Part 2 of this document AND the guidance notes **before** an application form is completed.

Applicants must submit a completed checklist with their application.

Part 1- You must be able to answer 'yes' to all the following to apply	
Your organisation:	Yes
