Conditions

- 1. Memorial plaques will not be permitted on or near trees. No additional mementoes, e.g. flowers, statues, vases, etc. will be permitted on or around the plant or tree.
- 2. Trees will be chosen to fit into the planting scheme of the chosen open space. A choice of trees and plants and their cost will be provided to the applicant.
- 3. The total cost of a tree will be dependent of the species of that chosen by the applicant. The Council charges will be in accordance with the current charging policy.
- 4. Throughout its existence, the tree will remain in the ownership of the Council.
- 5. The Council will maintain the tree in line with its current maintenance programme and reasonable effort will be taken by the Council to maintain the tree in good condition.
- 6. Although not liable for replacement, any tree or plant which dies, is damaged or is stolen, by whatever reason or means, the Council reserves the right to replace or refit the same entirely at its discretion and at its own expense.
- 7. The Council reserves the right to relocate or remove completely any tree if it is deemed to be in the Council's best interest. Notification of such action will be made to the applicant at his or her last known address.
