**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER A DECISION IN PRIVATE**

**Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012**

The intention to consider the following decision to be taken by the Cabinet in private was not publicised in accordance with regulation 5(2) of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012. The effect of this notice, which is set out in regulations 5(6) and 5(7) of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 is that the decision may be taken in private.

The Chair of the Scrutiny Commission has agreed that considering this item in private is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred because delaying the decision would mean that contractors could not be instructed with consequential impacts on the agreed programme.
