I would like to pass the following comment on Exam 75 : Transport strategy as I a, led to believe that you are the person collecting such comments.

As an over 75 who generally walks or cycles for shopping I welcome the policy to encourage more sustainable travel. I would point out however that the reality of what the County Council are doing is in some parts contrary to this objective. For example the road markings for joint pedestrian/cycleway use are worn in many locations and when road markings are renewed, the cycleway markings are not. I recently pointed out this to the County Council that near the Shelthorpe roundabout where the cycleway crosses Landsdown drive and the reply was that they no longer mark these.

Thus my comment is that somewhere in the document there should be an urgent strategy to upgrade all the old cycleway markings in the Loughborough and Shepshed area and to make it clear where cycleways cross and where there is joint pedestrian/cycle use and to expand the latter wherever possible and where conflicts can be avoided.
