Notice pursuant to Article 5(1) for the Making of an Article 4 Direction

## PLANNING CONTROLS OVER HOUSES IN MULTIPLE OCCUPATION

Charnwood Borough Council ("the Borough Council") made an Article 4(1) Direction on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2011 under Article 4 (1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, as amended. The Direction relates to development comprising change of use of a building to a use falling within Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) of the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 as amended from a use falling within Class C3 (dwelling houses) of that order, and removes permitted development rights for this type of development from the date when the Direction comes into force. Planning permission will therefore be required for change of use to Class C4 from Class C3 once the Article 4 Direction is in force.

The Article 4 Direction applies to all wards within Loughborough.
