



Thrussington Neighbourhood Plan Referendum Information Statement

This statement has been prepared to meet Regulation 4(3) (a) of the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendum) Regulations 2012 (as amended). A Referendum relating to the adoption of the Thrussington Neighbourhood Development Plan will be held on Thursday 2nd August 2018.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is: **Do you want Charnwood Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Thrussington to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?**

The Referendum area is identified on the map included within this information statement. It is the same area that has been designated as the Thrussington neighbourhood area.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if they are:

- Entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- Have a qualifying address for the election in the Referendum area. A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

A campaign for a 'yes' or 'no' vote will be subject to a Referendum expenses limit. The formula that sets the Referendum expenses limit is £2,362 plus 5.9p for each person entitled to vote in the Referendum.

A number of specified documents are available for the purpose of the Referendum. The specified documents for are:

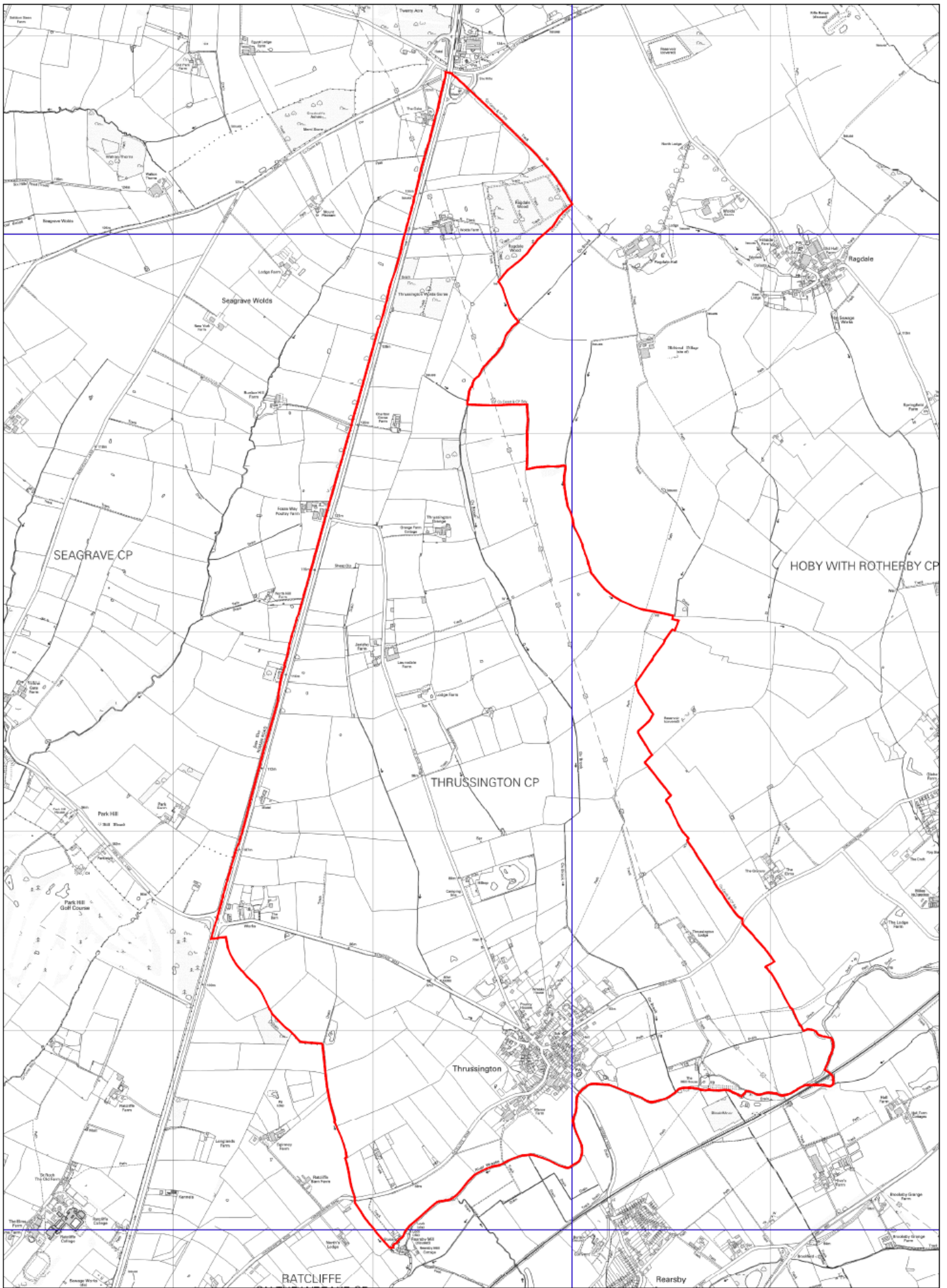
- The draft Thrussington Neighbourhood Plan

- Statement by the Local Planning Authority that the draft Plan meets the basic conditions
- A statement that sets out general information as to town and country planning including neighbourhood planning and the Referendum
